

Policies:

For the benefit of students and operation of the school, we ask each family to do their best to fulfill their financial commitment when enrolling their child(ren) for the academic school year.

Cancellation of services, such as tuition, transportation, or afterschool fees are subject to a **10%** charge based on the annual amount. There is no prorate/refund for cancellation of shuttle bus service. First tuition installment is due on June 1, 2020 and is non-refundable.

All policies governing fees, charges, and refunds are determined by the Board of Governors and implemented by school administration.

Financial Assistance:

Financial assistance may be granted to families who meet certain economic criteria.

Coastline Christian Schools was established in 1979 as an educational ministry of the Bay Area Chinese Bible Church. It continues to exist under the leadership of the church as a single 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. CCS has provided a comprehensive, academically excellent K-8 Christian educational program.

Application Fee:

A \$150 non-refundable fee is due upon submission of an application. This fee includes a standardized placement exam required for admission to CCS.

Enrollment Fee:

Newly admitted students pay a \$350 fee upon enrollment. Continuing students pay \$375 if enrolled by February 3, 2020 and \$550 thereafter. All enrollment fees are non-refundable.

The prepaid annual tuition or the 1st installment of the 10-payment plan is due on **June 1, 2020**. The first installment is non-refundable. Subsequent installments are due on the first of the every month beginning September 2020 through May 2021. Families using e-Tuition will receive a \$75 discount per family off their enrollment fee.

Additional expenses include textbooks, field trips, events and material fees for special classes which totals approximately \$800 (varies per grade). This does not include any afterschool enrichment programs, sports or other optional programs.

Extended Leave Policy:

We ask parents not to remove students from school for early or extended vacations as students will not benefit from the classroom learning environment. Parents may be responsible to pay for any additional cost incurred as a result of the extended vacation.

Food Service

Students can bring lunch from home or purchase hot lunch through the school's Food Service.

Transportation

A daily shuttle service is operated on school days between San Leandro and Alameda. The fee is \$250 (one way) and \$425 (both way) for the school year.
