# What is Google Classroom?

Think of Google Classroom (GC) as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use GC to share assignments, homework, newsletters, and much more with students AND parents!



# Getting Started



Your child has a Google Username/ email and Password that is unique to them.

Usernames and passwords were sent out from the IT Department to all parents in grades 1-8. In some cases, teachers are able to share this information as well.

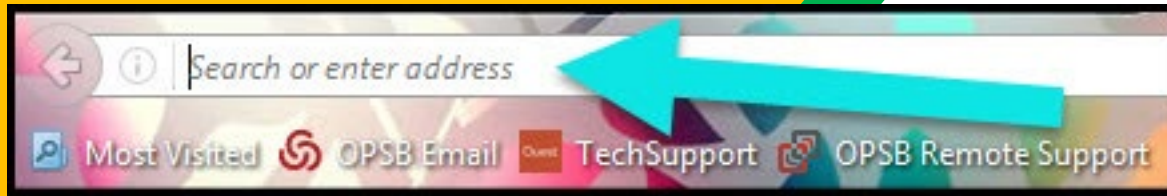

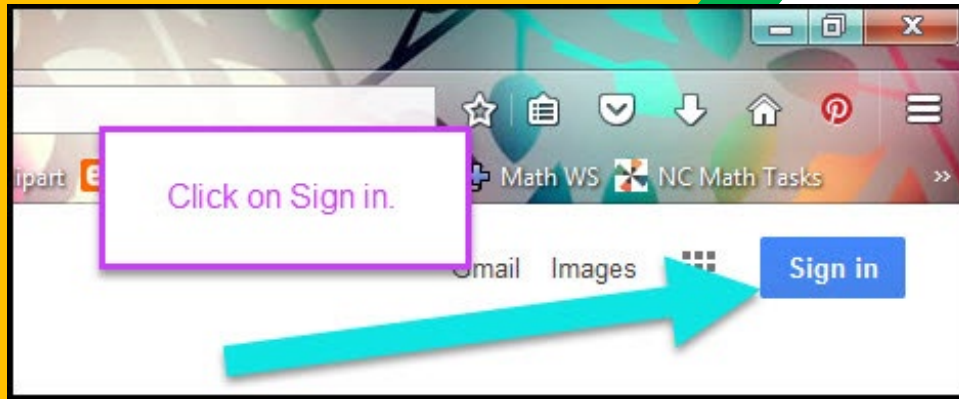

2 Type [www.google.com](http://www.google.com) into your web address bar.



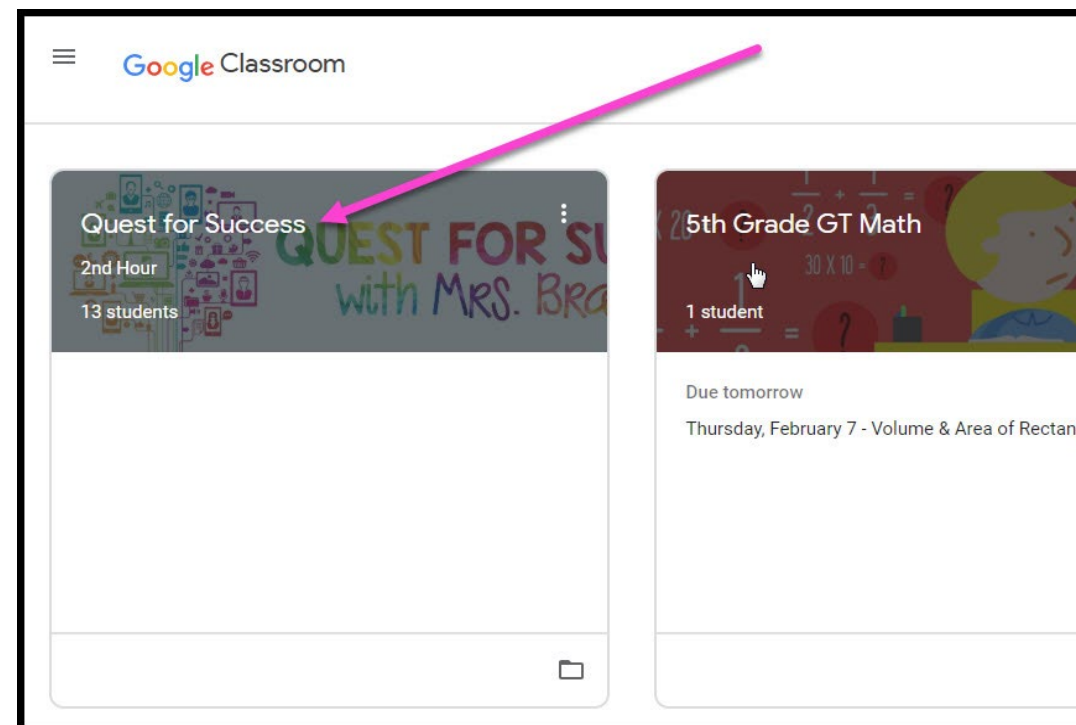
Click on the waffle button and then the Google Classroom icon.

Click on the class you wish to view or hit the “+” sign to put in a code for a new class.


